Guidelines for ISRB Young Scientist Award

Objectives of the Award:

To recognize the talented young research scholars/ scientists, who have shown extraordinary originality and dedication in their research programs in the field of Radiation biology, radiation oncology and allied branches.

Nature of the Award:

The award is exclusively meant for individual young scientists. The award carries a certificate and mementos which are given during conference organized under the aegis of ISRB

Instructions:

1. Usually three awards are given at a time. However, the number may be changed in proportion to the number of the participants.
2. The applicant can either be Research Scholar/Post Doctoral Fellow working in the field of Radiation Biology/Radiation Oncology.
3. Age of applicant should not be more than 35 years as on the first day of the conference.
4. Candidates should fill the declaration form given in brochure or on the conference website; and also bring original 10th class certificate for age proof along with them to the conference venue for verification of age.
5. The form should be duly forwarded by the concerning Head of the Department/Director of the Institute.
6. Young Scientist Award contestant may be short-listed on the basis of the quality of the abstracts, if required.
7. Awardees will be selected by the committee of eminent scientists on the basis of the presentation to be made by the candidate during the young scientist award session of the conference.

Guidelines for Mrs & Mr. MR Raju Award

Objectives of the Award:

To recognize the talented young scientists who have shown extraordinary originality and dedication in their research programs. They should have exceptional creativity based on a track record of significant contribution to research and potential to facilitate use of their expertise to further high-quality research in Radiation biology, radiation oncology and allied branches.

Nature of the Award:

The award is exclusively meant for individual young scientists. The award carries a cash prize of Rs 5000/-, a certificate and a memento.

Instructions:

1. Only one award given. However, if jury so decides, it may be shared amongst the eligible candidates.
2. The applicant can either be Research Scholar/Post-Doctoral Fellow/ scientist working in the field of Radiation Biology/Radiation Oncology.
3. The full-length research paper, complete in all respects, should be submitted along with detailed bio-data, on or before the deadline advertised on the conference website.
4. The entire research work should have been carried out in India.
5. Age of applicant should not be more than 40 years as on the first day of the conference.
6. Candidates should fill the declaration form given in brochure or on the conference website; and also bring original 10th class certificate for age proof along with them to the conference venue for verification of age.
7. The form should be duly forwarded by the concerning Head of the Department/Director of the Institute.
8. Awardees will be selected by the committee of eminent scientists on the basis of the research paper, biodata of the applicant. If required, the jury may conduct presentations of the contestants during the award session of the conference.
